The International Seminar on "Revisiting the issues of human rights of scheduled caste and scheduled tribes" was organized by Dr. Ambedkar Collage of social work, Wardha, Maharashtra organized, with the support of Indian institute of social science research ICSSR, New Dehli on 24th -25th June 2017 was a grand success where 105 participants from all over India actively participated in the academic deliberations.



The inaugural session started with the introductory remarks delivered by Mr.A. R.Bhele by thanking the convener of the conference organizing the seminar in the college and he thanked Indian Council Social Science Research (ICSSR), New

Delhi for financially supporting the Seminar. Dr. Milind Sawai expressed his views regarding the seminar during the inaugural session. Miss. Chetana Sawai expressed her views about the importance of the seminar and said that human rights of women must be achieved at any cost. Advocate Dhansingh Dhurve who were the chief guest of the seminar expressed his view on the problems of the Adivasi in India. Mr. Venkatesh, Assistant Professor, IFLU, Hyderabad was also present at the inaugural session. Hon'ble Pradip Subhedar who was the president of




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conference inaugurated the conference addressing the audience with his long experience of working tribals in India. He pointed towards the Indus Valley civilization and tribals contribution for its making.

The Conference was broadly divided into three technical sessions where papers were presented by the scholars on variousa spects of the situation of human rights of scheduled caste and scheduled tribe. It is interesting to note that both the young scholars and eminent academicians in the field of social science particularly those who are working on human rights



of dalit and adivasi both academically and as human rights activists participated in the deliberations.

The inaugural ceremony was followed by first technical session. The session was chaired was chaired by Mr. Venkatesh Adil, IFLU, Hyderabad. The first speaker in line was Anil Kumar from Jammu & Kashmir University. The other presentations were by

Adv. Dhansingh Dhurve on Adivasis in India and human rights, Mr. Subhedar sir from Chattisgarh, speaking on Adivasi culture and others. All the presentations were interesting and contemporary in their orientations. Mr. Venkatesh concluded the session with critical remarks on each presentation.

On the second day there were two technical sessions. The second session of the second day i.e. on 25th June 2018 was chaired by K.S. Patil from Tirpude College of social work, Nagpur. The speakers of the session were Dr. R.S. Markam from Raipur, Dr. Saroj Aglave, HOD, Department of Sociology, Women's College Nagpur, Mr. Lakshman from IFLU, Hyderabad, and Mr. Hari from IFLU, Hyderabad. A range of topics were covered during this session.

The third session i.e. of paper presentation was chaired by Dr. Saroj Dange. The paper presenters of the session were Dr. Gulshansing Sinha, Rajesh Lehkapure, Sandip Kumar Verma, Narendra Divakar and others. The second day of the Conference saw a number of presentations on topics ranging from socio-cultural issues of dalit and adivasis to legal, economic and political issues affecting the human right situations of dalits and adivasis across India. Scholars from different universities, colleges and think tanks from all over India presented their paper on the day.

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The Conference was concluded by a Valedictory Session which was followed by the distribution of certificates. Nearly forty eight papers were presented. Teachers and scholars from Major Universities, Think Tanks and Research Institutes across the country took part in

the conference. The certificates to the presenters and participants were distributed at the end of the seminar.

The proceeding of the seminar was published with ISBN number on the occasion of the seminar and was released during the inaugural session of the seminar.



In the contemporary times, untouchability continues to be practiced today against Dalits. In everyday life situation, ex-untouchables subjected to segregation, insult, humiliation and frustrations and there is continuous violation of their human rights both in terms of their civil rights and their identity with which they wants to live with freedom. The Adivasis are also becoming the victim of the imposed culture and are deprived of their civil rights and culture. India has the second largest tribal concentration in the world. In India, Scheduled Tribes are spread across the country mainly in forest and hilly regions. The essential characteristics of these communities are their particular geographical location, distinct culture, economic backwardness and algofness from the society at large. These people, in our country, are treated as low, despised and untouchable by the prevailing adherence to man-made social norms and caste system. They are compelled to perform duties which are considered inferior and degrading like flaying the dead animals, cleaning the latrines and removing the garbage, guarding the cremation grounds and grave yards, weaving, drum-beating, entertainment of upper caste people etc. Keeping this very in mind we are organizing this conference to revisit the issues of the human rights of scheduled castes and scheduled Tribes.

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



Objective of the Workshop:





Covid-19 in India started from 21st March 2020. Due to the rapid spread of Corona in the first phase of this epidemic, the number of Corona patients in India started increasing rapidly. As an effective measure to control the spread of Corona, the Government of India suspended the work of all government, non-government offices, educational institutions, public places, and their work and prohibited gatherings in public places and market areas. And providing services from home, the working method accepted.

The government issued some guidelines and rules for effective control of Corona epidemic. And implemented the system and procedure of government non-government employees for control work. There was no inclusion of social workers in the front line system of this service work. The lack of scientific handling of social and psychological problems and problems while working in this system was clearly evident. Due to this, an atmosphere of complete disagreement, misunderstanding and fear was created in the society. Keeping in mind all these facts, the situation of tension and mental fear created in the families and the general society in order to deal with and manage the social worker in a systematic way, to bring the importance and role of the social worker in the vision of the background government and social work educational institutions, students, former economic and social workers. When presenting the adverse effects of family members, treatment heads and domestic problems, family disputes due to work, hunger, addictions, visible behavior to the family is a very painful blow to the society. In fact, there is an urgent need for family counseling here. Women and children of the families of the village have started begging for alms in and outside the poor family due to economic evil. Many families have ration cards and residence documents like Aadhaar card etc. Many people do not get food due to lack of items. So in this work we can mediate between the collector office and such needy families and

help them by making a list in the villages and communities to supply them with food grains.

In family counseling, we can focus on their family conflicts, misunderstandings, harassment, etc. In this, you can use various technical tools. In the case of family violence, you can also take the help of the police system. Community Counseling Center, Mobile Counseling Service Helpline Center can work effectively with the help of Collector Office by taking the help of District Protection Officer and system of Women and Child Development Office. Information Center Counseling Center should be started through College of Social Work and through family survey real information about family behavior can be obtained. Economic and Industrial Labor Problems:

While analyzing the economic and industrial results, Dr. Ambadas Mohite said that the biggest impact of the corona epidemic was on industry and manufacturing. Loss incurred by Air India and Indian Air Line, hotels, industries, railways, industrial sector all the production sectors were shut down, the economic condition came to 04. The country lost thousands of crores of rupees. Also, the employment of lonka was lost. The employment of over two crore people was lost. More than 60 lakh people had to leave the cities and return home in whatever condition they felt at home, etc. We see the consequences of this kind of suffering of migrant workers in the media every day. People die on foot, accident

was They are being kept in the middle without any facility to return home.. This cannot be said to be an ideal model of disaster management at all. The number of hospital beds, health care, medicine is showing poor picture. People are falling prey to various rumors of the spread of the disease. We are all ostracizing them.

Social Effects - From a social point of view man is moving away from man. Social discord and distance is falling. Desecration of the house is seen as inhumane. How much the insensibility after death has increased. People are turning to alcohol due to misinformation. Social relations, relationships, all come to an end. Only a few social organizations and institutions come forward and lend a helping hand. But this facility is broken. Extortion and crime and economic poverty are gaining momentum.

According to the mental effects, the mental problems that arise in all people are mainly the result of the corona epidemic. Hence anxiety, despair, self-doubt, fear, prejudice, vaishya, angst, anger, suicidal tendencies, suicidal tendencies etc. Hence mutual trust is ending.

Nishant Parma sir gave the details information on District Legal Services Authority. This service is provided free of charge to those whose family income is less than 3 lakhs. 
